(Prostrations of Tilawat)

1st Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Al-Airaaf 7:207

إِنَّ الَّذِينَ عِنْدَ رَبِّكَ لَا يَسْتَكْبِرُونَ عَنْ عِبَادَتِهِ

وَيُسَبِّحُونَهُ وَلَهُ يَسْجُدُونَ

Truly, those who are near to thy Lord, turn not away with pride from His worship, but they glorify Him and prostrate themselves before Him.

2nd Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Ar-Ra'ad 13:16

وَلِلَّهِ يَسْجُدُ مَنْ فِي السَّمَوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضِ طَوْعًا

وَكَرْهًا وَظِلُّهُمُ بِالْغُدُوِّ وَالْآصَالِ



And to Allah submits whosoever is in the heavens and the earth willingly or unwillingly and likewise do their shadows, in the mornings and the evenings.

3rd Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah An-Nahl 50:51

وَلِلَّهِ يَسْجُدُ مَا فِي السَّمُوتِ وَمَا فِي الْأَرْضِ مِنْ

دَابَّةٍ وَالْمَلَائِكَةُ وَهُمْ لَا يَسْتَكْبِرُونَ ﴿٥٠﴾

يَخَافُونَ رَبَّهُمْ مِنْ فَوْقِهِمْ وَيَفْعَلُونَ مَا يُؤْمَرُونَ ﴿٥١﴾

And whatever is in the heavens and whatever creature is in the earth submits humbly to Allah, and the angels do too, and they do not behave proudly. They fear their Lord above them, and do what they are commanded.

4th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Bani Israel 17:108-110

قُلْ اٰمِنُوْا بِهٖ اَوْ لَا تُوْمِنُوْا ۚ اِنَّ الَّذِيْنَ اُوْتُوا الْعِلْمَ مِنْ
قَبْلِهٖ اِذَا يُتْلٰى عَلَيْهِمْ يَخِرُّوْنَ لِلْاَذْقَانِ سُجَّدًا ۝۱۰۸
وَيَقُوْلُوْنَ سُبْحٰنَ رَبِّنَا اِنْ كَانَ وَعْدُ رَبِّنَا لَمَفْعُوْلًا ۝۱۰۹
وَيَخِرُّوْنَ لِلْاَذْقَانِ يَسْكُوْنَ وَيَزِيْدُهُمْ خُشُوْعًا ۝۱۱۰

4th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Bani Israel 17:108-110

Say, "Whether you believe therein or believe not, those to whom knowledge has been given before it, do fall down prostrate on their faces when it is recited to them, 'And say, 'Holy is our Lord. Surely, the promise of our Lord is bound to be fulfilled.'" They fall down on their faces weeping, and it increases humility in them.

5th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Maryam 19:59

أُولَٰئِكَ الَّذِينَ أَنْعَمَ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِمْ مِنَ النَّبِيِّينَ مِنْ ذُرِّيَّةِ
آدَمَ ۖ وَمِمَّنْ حَمَلْنَا مَعَ نُوحٍ ۖ وَمِنْ ذُرِّيَّةِ إِبْرَاهِيمَ
وَإِسْرَءِيلَ ۖ وَمِمَّنْ هَدَيْنَا وَاجْتَبَيْنَا ۖ إِذَا تُتْلَىٰ
عَلَيْهِمْ آيَاتُ الرَّحْمَنِ خَرُّوا سُجَّدًا وَبُكِيًّا ۝

5th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Maryam 19:59

...When the Signs of the Gracious God were recited unto them, they fell down, prostrating themselves before God and weeping.

6th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Al-Hajj 22:19

أَلَمْ تَرَ أَنَّ اللَّهَ يَسْجُدُ لَهُ مَنْ فِي السَّمَوَاتِ وَمَنْ فِي الْأَرْضِ وَ
الشَّمْسُ وَالْقَمَرُ وَالنُّجُومُ وَالْجِبَالُ وَالشَّجَرُ وَالدَّوَابُّ
وَكَثِيرٌ مِّنَ النَّاسِ ^ط وَكَثِيرٌ حَقَّ عَلَيْهِ الْعَذَابُ ^ط وَمَنْ
يُهِنِ اللَّهُ فَمَا لَهُ مِنْ مُّكْرِمٍ ^ط إِنَّ اللَّهَ يَفْعَلُ مَا يَشَاءُ ^ط

6th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Al-Hajj 22:19

Have you not seen that to Allah submits whosoever is in the earth, and the sun, and the moon, and the stars, and the mountains, and the trees, and the beasts, and many of mankind? But there are many who become deserving of punishment. And whomsoever Allah disgraces, none can raise him to honour. Verily, Allah does what He pleases.

7th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Al-Hajj 22:78

يَا أَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا ارْكَعُوا
وَاسْجُدُوا وَاعْبُدُوا رَبَّكُمْ
وَافْعَلُوا الْخَيْرَ لَعَلَّكُمْ تُفْلِحُونَ

*O ye who believe! Bow down and prostrate yourselves in
Prayer, and worship your Lord, and do good deeds that
you may prosper*

8th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Al-Furqan 25:61

وَإِذَا قِيلَ لَهُمْ اسْجُدُوا لِلرَّحْمَنِ
قَالُوا وَمَا الرَّحْمَنُ أَنَسْجُدُ لِمَا
تَأْمُرُنَا وَزَادَهُمْ نُفُورًا

And when it is said to them, 'Submit to the Gracious God, they say, 'And who is the Gracious God? Shall we submit to whatever thou biddest us?' And it increases their aversion.

9th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah An-Naml 27:26-27

أَلَّا يَسْجُدُوا لِلَّهِ الَّذِي يُخْرِجُ الْخَبَاءَ فِي السَّمَوَاتِ
وَالْأَرْضِ وَ يَعْلَمُ مَا تُخْفُونَ وَمَا تُعْلِنُونَ ﴿٢٦﴾
اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ رَبُّ الْعَرْشِ الْعَظِيمِ ﴿٢٧﴾

*And Satan had bidden them not to worship Allah, Who brings to light that which is hidden in the heavens and the earth, and Who knows what you conceal and what you make known.
Allah! There is no God but He, the Lord of the Mighty Throne.*

10th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah As-Sajda 32:16

إِنَّمَا يُؤْمِنُ بِآيَاتِنَا الَّذِينَ إِذَا ذُكِّرُوا
بِهَا خَرُّوا سُجَّدًا وَسَبَّحُوا بِحَمْدِ
رَبِّهِمْ وَهُمْ لَا يَسْتَكْبِرُونَ



Only they believe in Our Signs who, when they are reminded of them, fall down prostrate and celebrate the praises of their Lord, and they are not proud.

11th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Saad 38:25

— وَظَنَّ دَاوُدُ أَنَّمَا فَتَنَّاهُ فَاسْتَغْفَرَ

رَبَّهُ وَخَرَّ رَاكِعًا وَأَنَابَ 

....And David perceived that We had tried him; so he asked forgiveness of his Lord, and fell down bowing in worship and turned to Him.

12th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Haa Miim Sajda 41:39

وَمِنْ آيَاتِهِ اللَّيْلُ وَالنَّهَارُ وَالشَّمْسُ وَالْقَمَرُ^ط
لَا تَسْجُدُوا لِلشَّمْسِ وَلَا لِلْقَمَرِ وَاسْجُدُوا لِلَّهِ
الَّذِي خَلَقَهُنَّ إِن كُنتُمْ إِيَّاهُ تَعْبُدُونَ ﴿٣٩﴾ فَإِنْ
اسْتَكْبَرُوا فَالَّذِينَ عِنْدَ رَبِّكَ يُسَبِّحُونَ لَهُ
بِاللَّيْلِ وَالنَّهَارِ وَهُمْ لَا يَسْأَمُونَ ﴿٤٠﴾

12th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Haa Miim Sajda 41:39

And among His Signs are the night and the day and the sun and the moon. Prostrate not yourselves before the sun, nor before the moon, but prostrate yourselves before Allah, Who created them, if it is Him Whom you really worship. But if they turn away with disdain they do it to their own detriment, while those who are with thy Lord glorify Him night and day, and they are never wearied.

13th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah An-Najum 53:63

السجدة
فَاسْجُدْ وَاعْبُدْ اللَّهَ

So prostrate yourselves before Allah, and worship Him.

14th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Al-Inshiqaaq 84:22

وَإِذَا قُرِئَ عَلَيْهِمُ الْقُرْآنُ
لَا يَسْجُدُونَ



*And when the Qur'an is recited unto them, they do not bow
down in submission*

15th Sajda of Tilawat (prostration of recitation)

Surah Al-'Alaq 96:20

كَلَّا ط لَا تُطِيعُهُ
وَاسْجُدْ وَاقْتَرِبْ

*Nay, yield not thou to him, but prostrate thyself
and draw near to God.*

Prayers of Sujood-ut-Tilawah

(Prostrations of Tilawat)

Prayer of Sujood-ut-Tilawah

اَللّٰهُمَّ سَجَدَ لَكَ رُوْحِيْ
وَ جَسَدِيْ وَ جَنَانِيْ

*O Allah, my soul, my body and my heart are
prostrated before you.*

Prayer of Sujood-ut-Tilawah

سَجَدَ وَجْهِي لِلَّذِي خَلَقَهُ وَشَقَّ

سَمْعَهُ وَبَصَرَهُ بِحَوْلِهِ وَقُوَّتِهِ

فَتَبَارَكَ اللَّهُ أَحْسَنُ الْخَالِقِينَ

Prayer of Sujood-ut-Tilawah

اَللّٰهُمَّ اَكْتُبْ لِيْ بِهَا عِنْدَكَ اَجْرًا ، وَضَعْ عَنِّيْ بِهَا
وِزْرًا ، وَاجْعَلْهَا لِيْ عِنْدَكَ ذُخْرًا ، وَتَقَبَّلْهَا مِنِّيْ كَمَا
تَقَبَّلْتَهَا مِنْ عَبْدِكَ دَاوُدَ ،

How to perform prostration of Tilawat

Points to be remembered - 1

- Ablution is not essential but desirable and recommended.
- There is no need to say Takbeer while going to prostration and after its completion outside Salaat.
- There is no need to say '*Assalamu Alaikum Wa Rahmatullah*' on both sides after its completion.
- Sajda of Tilawat is the Sunnah of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (s.a.w). Sajda of Tilawat is not considered obligatory so if one forgets it is not compulsory for him to perform it.

Points to be remembered - 2

- If one does not know the prayer one should say 'Tasbeeh' of Sajda. However, one should make sincere efforts to memorise the particular prayer(s).
- Facing towards Ka'aba is not compulsory. However, it is desirable and recommended.
- Sajda of Tilawat may be performed at any time.
- Qur'anic prayers cannot be recited in Sajdah.
